Overview:

The Associate Dean of Academic Affairs reports to the Dean of the College of Naturopathic Medicine, and is responsible for the growth, maintenance and development of the academic program and faculty of the College. Essential functions of this position include academic leadership, guidance of students through the program and liaison responsibilities between the College, the Office of the Registrar and various other offices related to matters of student enrollment, grades, course scheduling and College operations.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Oversees the curriculum and assessment; identifies and makes recommendations of changes to the Dean, regarding best educational practices and in compliance with CNME standards
- Chairs Curriculum and Assessment
- Facilitates program curriculum review and development
- Facilitates development of program assessment
- Serves on the CCACO working group as a representative of UBCNM
- Advises and registers students
- Oversees students' grades, credits, standing, schedules, eligibilities, etc.
- Determines disciplinary action based on the student handbook (i.e., academic probation, professional conduct, dismissal letters)
- Organizes NPLEX reviews
- Oversees faculty. Develops faculty load report each term. Prepares and reviews adjunct faculty contracts. Observes faculty instruction in the classroom.
- Participates in the recruitment and selection processes of faculty and staff
- Other duties as assigned by program Dean

Position Qualifications:

- A professional or academic doctoral degree required, with an ND degree preferred
- Experience in naturopathic medicine and higher education is highly desirable
- Teaching experience at the professional college level is required
- Demonstrated leaderships skills required
- Previous administrative experience preferred
