THE INSTITUTION

Overview:

Le Moyne College is an independent college established by the Jesuits in 1946. The McDevitt Center for Creativity & Innovation:

The McDevitt Center for Creativity and Innovation is a newly endowed center at Le Moyne College that is supported by a 50-million-dollar gift from the estate of Robert and Kay McDevitt. The Center is intended to position Le Moyne as a leading regional and national sponsor of hi-impact programs and initiatives that advance awareness of the latest research in Computer Science, Management/Information Systems, Physics, and Religious Philosophy.

Each of the Center's programs and initiatives is developed in conjunction with, and led by, a nationally/internationally prominent individual who is working at the forefront of one of these disciplinary areas. Each of those invited to lead an initiative through the McDevitt Center are appointed as McDevitt Chair in the relevant discipline. The position of McDevitt Chair is a short-term, visiting appointment (normally not exceeding one academic year) that does not require full-time residence at Le Moyne College and may be held concurrently with other appointments.

THE OPPORTUNITY

The Position:

The newly endowed McDevitt Chair in Computer Science will represent the heart of the McDevitt Center's faculty programming and initiatives in **Cyber Security**. The Chair will be filled through a visiting appointment for the 2014-15 academic years. The appointment may be concurrent with other appointments. All other programs and initiatives directly supported by the McDevitt Center are oriented around and informed by the questions, projects, and challenges engaged by the Chair and are intended to bring distinction to the Chair and enhance his/her value to Le Moyne College.

The Chair will be occupied in short-term appointments by an eminent thinker and researcher who is at the forefront of the cyber security discipline. The Chair's work will engage emerging developments, perennial questions, or grand challenges; apply cyber security across several disciplines; enrich research and teaching of Le Moyne's regular faculty; enhance the education of students; and demonstrate a mindful regard for values and a commitment to using research to positively impact our world.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Lead a master class intended primarily for faculty from area colleges and universities, area information technology professionals (from banking, health care, DOD, etc.), and advanced students which would meet 6 times during the fall of 2014.
- With ample logistical assistance and support, organize and host a 2-3 day cyber security conference in the spring of 2015.
- While on campus for master class sessions, participate in invited talks, visits to undergraduate classes, McDevitt Center events, etc.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Recognized leadership in the field of cyber security.
- Active research/work at the forefront of the current state of the art.
- Extensive national/international professional network requisite for hosting significant conference.
- Broad experience with cyber security challenges/solutions in a broad range of domains, industries, disciplines.

Compensation:

Compensation will be determined based on the incumbent's qualifications.
