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### The Position:

Reporting to the Dean and as a core teaching faculty member, the **Full Professor** will be responsible for educating future leaders in addiction counseling to improve treatment and recovery from alcohol and drug dependence. This position may have responsibilities in residential and/or online programs. This position innovates and continuously improves key education processes based on educational research, internal assessment data, and academic expertise, so that course offerings, teaching strategies and curriculum development demonstrate improved achievement of learning outcomes. Positions at **Assistant Professor** and **Associate Professor** rank are available for qualified individuals as well.

### Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

- Teach and revise course content to ensure optimum learning outcomes.
- Provide supervision necessary to promote acquisition of incremental student competency through clinical laboratory and internship experiences.
- Provide academic advising and coaching in order to promote successful scholastic adjustment and school performance.
- Continually seek and demonstrate knowledge in higher learning and the field of recovery in order to facilitate the development of expertise in students and other professionals.
- May design and deliver online courses and develop relevant policies and procedures with direction from the Director of Online Learning.
- Participate in all aspects of the Graduate School in order to promote continuous improvement of key educational processes.
- Demonstrates academic leadership through expert teaching practices including educational research, program innovation, curriculum design and related publications.
- Assure a safe and secure environment for patients, staff, guests and visitors.

### Qualifications:

- Doctorate in counseling, psychology, education or closely related field.
- Evidence of progressively responsible performance post-doctorate in substance dependence and treatment or closely related counseling field.
- Minimum 8 years of full-time teaching experience in higher education.
- Evidence of significant contributions to the fields of education and substance abuse, such as program development, clinical and/or administrative leadership, service innovation, specialization in desired academic concentration.
- Research and/or professional publications.

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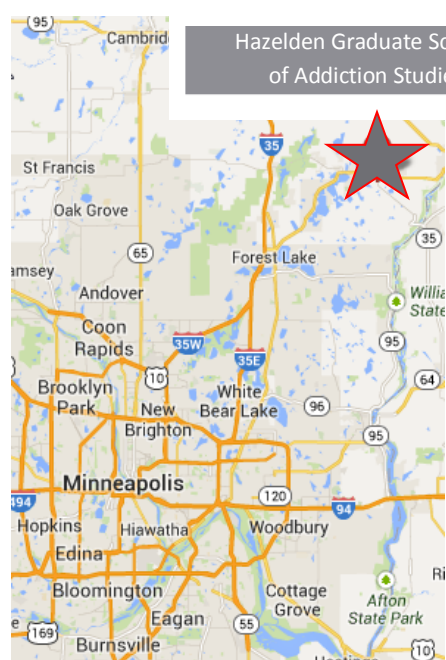


## Chisago County, Center City and Twin Cities of Minnesota
