

THE OPPORTUNITY

The ITS Network Engineer reports to the Senior Network Engineer and Analyst within the Networking and Telecommunications department. He/she will perform complex engineering, problem solving, installation, and implementation of Local Area Networking, Wide Area Networking, Wireless Local Area Networking, Voice over IP, Telecommunications Systems, and associated infrastructure. This person has the primary responsibility for meeting and fulfilling ITS/ISEC security initiatives as well to ensure the network infrastructure meets established security policies. He/she will supervise the Network Security Administrator.

Key Responsibilities:

- Research, develop, maintain, implement, and install IT security solutions and initiatives including firewalls, DMZ, intrusion detection/prevention systems, traffic/bandwidth management, VPNs, and application load balancing solutions.
- Conduct reviews of network security architecture, information security administration and policy as it applies to the network architecture.
- Perform complex networking and telecommunications engineering and analytical tasks.
- Design, configure, install, maintain, repair, monitor, manage, evaluate, test, and advise on LAN/WAN/WLAN/VoIP infrastructure, network operating systems, network servers, as well as monitoring and security systems.
- Make independent decisions critical to the daily operation of voice, video, and data network stability, security, reliability and operation, which may or may not be based on established policy and/or guidelines.
- Monitor data integrity and system security.
- Ensure networking and network OS standards compliance.

- Ensure compliance with nationally recognized laws, acts, policies, standards, and practices to include, but not limited to PCI, HIPPA, FERPA, HEOA, and CALEA.
- In charge of 24 x 7 on-call responsibilities.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

- Bachelor's Degree in Information Technology field with three years minimum full-time
 hands-on experience (or) technical degree/certificate in telecommunications/networking, or
 related field with five years minimum full-time hands-on experience (or) seven years fulltime hands-on experience.

- Comprehensive knowledge and experience designing, installing, monitoring, configuring, and managing, network security initiatives, applications, appliances, and hardware/software implementations.
- Comprehensive knowledge and experience in networking and telecommunications concepts, principles, applications, protocols, design, configuration, installation, and system management of routers, switches, networking operating systems, servers, VPNs, etc., in a converged LAN/WAN/WLAN/VoIP environment.
- Comprehensive knowledge and experience in maintenance procedures and equipment analysis, evaluation, testing, and consulting.
- Comprehensive knowledge and experience with diverse transport protocols over copper, fiber optics, circuits, and wireless infrastructures.
- Comprehensive knowledge and experience in packet and protocol analysis.
- Comprehensive knowledge and clear understanding of the OSI model with experience working at all layers and associated protocol stacks.
