Founded in 1910, Radford University (RU) serves the nation as one of the Commonwealth of Virginia's 15 public universities through a wide range of academic, cultural, human service, and research programs. In 2021, Radford University was classified as a Carnegie Doctoral/Professional University (D/PU) and now offers its nearly 9,000 student body a choice of 76 bachelor's degree programs in 47 disciplines, three associate degrees, and six certificates at the undergraduate level; 28 master's programs in 23 disciplines; and six doctoral programs at the graduate level. The University also offers 13 post-baccalaureate certificates and one post-master's certificate.

First and foremost, the University emphasizes teaching and learning and the process of learning in its commitment to the development of mature, responsible, well-educated citizens. Radford University develops students' creative and critical thinking skills, teaches students to analyze problems and implement solutions, helps students discover their leadership styles, and fosters their growth as leaders. The end result is a university that is student-focused and promotes a sense of caring and of meaningful interaction among all members of the University community.

Well known for its strong faculty/student bonds, innovative use of technology in the learning environment and vibrant student life on a beautiful 211-acre American classical campus, Radford University offers students many opportunities to get involved and succeed in and out of the classroom. A Division I member of the NCAA and Big South Conference, Radford University competes in 16 men's and women's varsity athletics. With over 300 clubs and organizations, Radford University offers many opportunities for student engagement, leadership development and community service. In addition to robust academic offerings and engaging student experiences on the main campus in Radford, Virginia, the University also offers a clinical-based educational experience for more than 1,100 students living and learning in Roanoke as part of Radford University Carilion (RUC), a public-private partnership focused on the cutting-edge delivery of health sciences programming, outreach, and service. Located in Roanoke's Innovation Corridor, Radford offers undergraduate and graduate degrees in the health sciences. With a faculty comprised of practicing clinicians, students are exposed to patient care and research opportunities.

Radford University seeks an energetic individual for the administrative and professional faculty position of Director of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement (IEQI). The Director of IEQI will report directly to the Assistant Provost for Budget and Academic Operations. They will be responsible for and have oversight of university-wide assessment planning and implementation process, serve as the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) Liaison, and will facilitate the off-site and on-site team visits in the fall of 2022 and the spring of 2023. In addition, the Director will:

- Ensure institutional compliance with accreditation requirements, coordinate the preparation of the annual profiles, substantive change proposals, fifth-year reports, and decennial review reports.
- Organize academic programs and co-curricular assessment planning and implementation in collaboration with faculty, department chairs, program directors, college assessment committees, and the general staff. Oversee the management of the Tk20 system for organizing assessment data and reports.
- Direct the administration and management of university-wide assessment measures.
- Collect and analyze data using both quantitative and qualitative techniques to inform continuous improvements of programs and services.
- Conduct assessment training workshops and presentations as well as provide online learning resources to faculty and staff to aid them in their institutional effectiveness activities.
- Manage the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement by providing oversight and direction to a team of three including an Associate Director, an Accreditation Specialist, and the SACSCOC Accreditation Coordinator and office manager.

Required Qualifications:

- Experience maintaining compliance with SACSCOC (or other regional accrediting bodies) accreditation standards, policy, and procedures.
- Experience with institutional and academic assessment; specifically with organizing, writing, and submitting reaffirmation and substantive change reports.
- Experience coordinating the collection and analysis of institution wide quantitative and qualitative data.
- Demonstrated experience working independently and collaboratively with diverse campus constituents.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Master's degree required; a doctorate/terminal degree would distinguish the candidate.
- Experience managing office operations and supervising employees.
- Experience as a SACSCOC reviewer or site visitor.
- Knowledge of Tk20 for organizing assessment data and reports.
