Collaborative Patient-Focused Evidence-Based

As an institution focused solely on health professions, SCU has developed the SCU Model of Interprofessional Education, providing students with an immersive, interprofessional academic experience. Interprofessional education topics are integrated into the curriculum of every program. Integrative health symposia, campus events, integrative rounds, cocurricular learning, and campus clubs provide students additional opportunities to learn from, with, and about other health professions. Regardless of program of study, SCU graduates are taught to understand and appreciate different approaches, treatment options and philosophies of health and well-being.



THE OPPORTUNITY

Dean of Interprofessional Education

Integrative health is the driving force behind SCU's Interprofessional Education Program. The Dean of Interprofessional Education is a proactive, confident, goal-oriented self-starter driven to make a difference in integrative, whole person health. Persuasive, conceptual, independent, and fast-paced, the Dean works with multiple internal constituents, establishes relationships with external constituents, and prioritizes opportunities to position SCU as an industry leader in integrative, whole-person health. The ideal candidate will be an influential and creative leader in the world of integrative health and medicine.

This newly created role is a once-in-a-career opportunity to implement an innovative Doctor of Integrative Health (DIH) to prepare graduates of integrative health and medicine fellowships as leaders and change agents for the advancement of integrative, whole-person health. The DIH is overseen by the Dean of Interprofessional Education with the assistance of a Program Director. In addition, the Dean is responsible for implementing SCU's Model Interprofessional Education. The Model was approved in 2020 and includes efforts to infuse Interprofessional Education Collaborative core competencies throughout all curricular and co-curricular learning at SCU. It includes Care Pathways that promote collaborative care. The Dean will promote SCU's IPE framework, infrastructure, and policies across the university; collaborate with SCU Health Systems and programs to assure each meets required IPE outcomes; and support teaching and learning in interprofessional courses. The Dean will help lead culture transformation around integrative health, interprofessional education, and interdisciplinary practice at SCU, ultimately taking its approach from a feature of the curriculum to a perspective on health and well-being that permeates all educational and health service offerings within the campus community. The Dean directly manages the Program Director for the Doctor of Integrative Health and the faculty of the Department of Interprofessional Education. The Dean is an Administrator II (non-faculty) reporting directly to the Vice President of Academic Affairs. Occasional teaching duties may be required.

Remote Opportunity: This position will require building strong relationships across the campus, with stakeholders and advisors. Candidates for this position will have the option to work on campus, hybrid, or in a fully remote capacity. Occasional on-campus duties will require travel to campus in order to build capacity. Travel costs will be covered by the university.

Duties and Responsibilities - Your Mission:

- Oversee Doctor of Integrative Health program with assistance of Program Director.
- Oversee and develop the University's relationship with the Academy of Integrative Health and Medicine; identify and cultivate similar relationships.
- Represent SCU externally to relevant organizations.
- Chair the IPE Council.
- Oversee the development, maintenance, and continuous improvement of IPE courses and content.
- Hire, develop, monitor, evaluate, and develop IPE faculty.
- Oversee the development and implementation of Care Pathways (Spine, Osteoarthritis, Anxiety/Depression and Headache).
- Oversee the assessment of IPE-related co-curricular learning.
- Oversee standardized patients for IPE related courses and events.
- Oversee and ensure the assessment of IPE-related University Learning Outcomes.
- Oversee and ensure the assessment of IPEC competencies.
- In collaboration with the Center for Faculty Development and Excellence, develop training to promulgate best practices in teaching and learning IPE related topics and courses.
- Identify and promote opportunities for faculty to advance knowledge and skills related to IPE.
- Create and oversee faculty and student recognition programs related to IPE.

- Submit application to ACIMH for membership; promote participation in and submission to ACIMH publications, workshops, symposia. Identify and promote similar opportunities.
- In collaboration with clinical program leaders, ensure development of IPE-related clinical course learning objectives and implementation of IPE clinical assessments.
- Liaise with SCU's Health System to optimize student and faculty clinical interprofessional experience/opportunities.
- Promote IPE scholarly activity and dissemination efforts to share innovative, evidence-based, best practices in IPE.
- Encourage and focus students on engagement with IPE-focused student organizations and opportunities.
- Evaluate and incorporate guidance from agencies and reports as appropriate (e.g. Health Profession Accreditors Collaborative's Guidance on Developing Quality Interprofessional Education for the Health Professions).
- Serve on University task forces and committees as required.
- Participate in accreditation processes as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Qualifications, Skills, and Abilities:

- Doctoral degree preferably in medical, healthcare, or integrative health-related field.
- Evidence of commitment to integrative health (e.g., leadership, publications, fellowship, board approval, etc.).
- Experience working in higher education, continuing medical education, or a similar education/training environment.
- The ideal candidate will be a graduate of an integrative health and medicine fellowship or have participated in similar training and education.
- The ideal candidate will have knowledge of and experience in interprofessional education in a college or university setting.
- Teaching experience preferred.
- Knowledge of educational theory and methodology, instructional design, student evaluation and outcome assessment are highly desirable.
